GET TO KNOW THE COUPLE

Getting them to open up will improve the overall experience.



THEN, MAKE A PHOTOSHOOT LIST

Consists of wedding sequence, important moments to capture and any other special requests from the couple.



UNDERSTAND THEIR PHOTOGRAPHY STYLE

Every shot should express who they are.



TAKE AS MANY SHOTS AS POSSIBLE

The more, the better the variety to choose from.



LOOK LIKE A PRO

Look smart, act the part, dress like a professional.



KNOW WHO'S INVITED

Get your hands on the guest list, if possible. Make sure everyone gets in the shot.



ALWAYS SHOOT IN RAW

Makes editing a lot better.



SCOUT THE VENUE

Start early. Get a feel of the place. Plan angles and possible shots.

THE MOVE
Stay active, out of the way, but always there for the perfect shot.
