


# WILDLIFE SHOOT

#### **CAMERA**

**EOS R**

#### **BATTERIES**

Take enough fully charged batteries to ensure your camera will not go flat.

#### **MEMORY CARDS**


Be sure to bring as many extra SD cards as you think you'll need.

#### **CAMERA STRAP**


Prevent accidental, costly slips by strapping your camera around your neck.

#### **CLEANING KIT**


Bring along a lens blower and microfiber lens cleaning cloth to clean it whenever necessary.

#### **TRIPOD**

#### **OTHER NECESSITIES**
